Career Highlights:

Qualified for the 2012 Olympic team by finishing second in the 100m breast ... Finished fourth in the 200m breast at the 2011 FINA World Championships ... Also took fourth in the 200m breast at the 2011 ConocoPhillips National Championships ... Captured the 2010 national title in the 200m breast ... won a gold medal and set a new world record as a member of the 4x100m medley-relay at the 2009 FINA World Championships... won silver in the 200m breast and placed fourth in the 100m breast at the 2009 World Championship ... won the 200m breast and set an American record in the event at 2009 Nationals ... at the 2008 Olympic Games advanced to the semi-finals in the 200m breast, placing tenth in the event ... finished fifth in the 200m breast while competing in his first World Championships in 2007 ... became the first American ever to sweep the individual medley events at 2005 World University Games, setting a new Universiade record in the 200m IM ... won bronze in the 400m IM at the 2004 Short Course World Championships ... finished third in the 200m and 400m IM at the 2004 Olympic Trials
