
## General Information for the Super Sectional Meet at the University at Buffalo

1. This meet is well over the 600 athlete mark- closer to 875 athletes, including relay only swimmers. As per the meet announcement, this means that there will be a D final in the prelim-final events. This D final will be filled with athletes who are 18 and under only. Questions regarding this extra heat will be addressed at the General Meeting on Wednesday.

**PLEASE** make sure that you are in attendance for this meeting- you are responsible for everything that is discussed at this meeting. Teams that are not coming into town until later in the meet can ask for meeting minutes at check-in.

- 2. A psych sheet is posted online. Any entries with an \* indicates that the time has not been proven yet. Please contact Tim Husson, the Admin Referee, if you need to prove a time. - 3. Due to the large number of athletes, there is the distinct possibility of a session start time change, both for prelims and finals. Details still need to be worked out during this extra entry period, but further announcements will be along shortly, and this will be discussed during the General Meeting.
- 4. Parking- Parking at this meet is free- there are a few lots that are close to the building. Please see the map posted on the STAR website Alumni Arena is building 1 on the map.
  - Teams should use the Arena Lot, and Lake La Salle lots. When you are at the pool, these will appear to be behind the building. Athletes and teams should use the entrance on the lower level on the Arena Lot side (closest to the football stadium and tennis courts). Any teams traveling by buses or larger vans can drop athletes off int he bus lot next to Alumni Arena (lower right-hand side of the building on the map), and can then park in the Stadium lot for the session.
  - Spectators should use the Slee A and B lots, as well as the Baird A and B lots. They should enter on the upper level closest to the Slee A lot, and the Center for the Arts (Building 2 on the map).
