ELIGIBILITY:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Open to all Virginia Swimming athletes registered by the first day of the meet. No on deck Virginia Swimming athlete registration will be permitted. Age on June 3, 2011 will determine age for the entire meet. 						
DISABILITY SWIMMERS:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Athletes with a disability are welcomed and shall provide advance notice of desired accommodations to the Meet Director. The athlete (or the athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the session referee of any disability prior to the competition. 						
FORMAT:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Swimmers of all ages entered in distance events will swim Friday evening. All 12 & Under swimmers will swim on Saturday and Sunday morning. All 13 & Over swimmers will swim on Saturday and Sunday afternoon. 11 & Over 800 Free will be swum on Saturday following the afternoon session. All events will be timed finals. 						
WARM-UP:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Friday night warm-ups are general from 3:00-3:45 pm and specific warm-ups from 3:45-4:00 pm; competition starts at 4:15 pm Morning sessions: Warm-ups at: 7:00 am; competition starts at 8:00 am. Afternoon sessions: Warm-ups will not start before 12:00 pm; competition will not start before 1:00 pm. Saturday Distant Session: Girls and Boys 800 freestyle will have a 10 minute general warm-up with the session starting 5 minutes thereafter. Lane assignment and warm-up times for individual clubs will be posted on the www.obxswimclub.com website no later than June 1, 2011, and will also be emailed to the contact person of the participating clubs. If any session runs late, the following session warm-ups will begin immediately after the earlier session ends. Depending on the number of entries, the meet director reserves the right to change the start time and format of warm-ups. Teams would be notified not later than Tuesday, May 31, 2011 						
ENTRIES:	<p>DEADLINE FOR THE RECEIPT OF ENTRIES IS TUESDAY, MAY 24, 2011</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Entries must be submitted in long course meter times using Hy-Tek Team Manager and Commlink-2 software, or on a VSI master entry sheet. Teams submit entries via e-mail A Team Manager printout of entries must be included or the meet checklist/summary sheet with the name of the person to contact in case of questions must accompany the entries, regardless of how they are submitted. 						

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Coach Time (CT) and “No Time” (NT) entries will be accepted for events in which a swimmer does not have a time of record. CT may not exceed a “BB” time. All entry times other than CT must have been achieved in USA Swimming sanctioned, approved, or observed competition. Swimmers may enter a maximum of 3 <i>individual events</i> per day, and 1 event on Friday. Entries will be processed in the order received and accepted to the greatest extent possible without exceeding the 4-hour/session timeline limit. Confirmation of acceptance of your teams’ entries into the meet will be sent via email. The Meet Director reserves the right to limit entries in any events, if necessary, to prevent too lengthy a session. This may include combining heats and events, which actions may require reseeding. FEES:	<p>Individual events: \$5.00 Swimmer surcharge: \$2.50 per person (entered in the meet in any capacity)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Checks should be made payable to: OBX Swim Club. Payment must be received by May 31, 2011 for email entries. Payment must be included with all mailed entries. Failure to pay entry fees by this deadline could result in teams being barred from the meet.
AWARDS:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Individual events: Ribbons will be awarded for first (1st) through eighth (8th) place. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> 11 & Over events will be given separate awards for 11-12, 13-14, and 15 & Over age groups 13 & Over events will be given separate awards for 13-14 and 15 & Over age groups. 10 & Under events will be given separate awards for 9-10 and 8 & Under age groups. Heat winner ribbons will be awarded for individual events.
SEEDING:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All events will be pre-seeded, except the distance events 1-2 (11&O 400 IM), 3-4 (12&U 400 Free), 5-6 (13&O 400 Free), and 29-30 (11&O 800 Free) which will be deck seeded. Swimmers should report directly to the blocks for their events Events 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 29, and 30 will require a positive check-in to swim. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Positive check-in for events 1-2 (11&O 400 IM) will close at 4:00 pm. Positive check-in for events 3-4 (12&U 400 Free) and 5-6 (13&O400 Free) will close at 4:15 pm Positive check-in for events 29-30 (11&O 800 Free) will close at 2:00 pm. SWIMMERS FAILING TO POSITIVELY CHECK-IN WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO SWIM THE EVENT. Events 29 & 30 (11&O 800 Freestyle) will be swum fastest to slowest alternating girls and then boys
PENALTIES:	<p>Penalties for entries using fraudulent and/or non-verifiable entry times:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Swimmer shall be marked as exhibition for the event entered illegally and the event shall be re-scored and awarded. Club may be fined \$100 for each offense, and a record of such offenses shall be kept and published as part of the official meet results. Clubs entering swimmers not legally registered with USA Swimming by the first day of the meet may be fined \$100 per swimmer in each event so entered. If the swimmer is representing a club in competition, the fine will be levied on the Club. If the swimmer is unattached, the fine will be levied on the swimmer.
RULES:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations will apply. Swimmers in the meet, unaccompanied by a USA-S coach must be certified by a USA-S coach as proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. Ensuring compliance is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer’s legal guardian.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The overhead start procedure will be used for the afternoon sessions, and may be used for the morning sessions at the discretion of the Referee. In accordance with VSI Policy, only those coaches who have current, valid USA Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet. Coaches who do not possess these credentials will be required to leave the deck area.

Team Officials Chairpersons should submit the names and session availability of certified officials, as well as the names and session availability of trainees to Elizabeth Gamiel, Email: kegtherapies@yahoo.com or Phone: (252) 305-2951. Officials are asked to be present no later than one (1) hour prior to the start of the session and attend an Officials' Meeting in Room 102.
SAFETY:	Virginia Swimming Meet Safety Procedures will be in effect.
TIMERS:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Clubs will be required to provide timers in proportion to the number of swimmers they have entered in each session. The number of timers required per club and their lane assignments will be posted on the www.obxswimclub.com no later than June 1, 2011, and will also be emailed to the contact person of each of the individual clubs. Swimmers will be expected to provide their own timers and lap counters for events 29-30, 11&O 800 Free
GENERAL:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Meet Programs: Heat sheets and/or psych sheets will be sold for \$5.00 Snack Bar/food: A snack bar/food vendors will be available during the meet Swim Shop: Swim Shop provided by Aquawear will be open during the meet Hospitality: OBX Swim Club will provide a Hospitality Room for coaches, officials and officials in training. Breakfast and lunch will be served. Drinks and snacks will be provided during the day First Aid: A staffed First Aid Station is located at the end of the pool near the entrance to the locker rooms. Lost and Found: Lost and Found will be located next to the announcer's table.
RESULTS:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All results will be posted on the wall in the hallway near the snack bar Meet results will be e-mailed to all participating teams within 24 hours of the conclusion of the meet. The results will be posted to the Virginia Swimming web site www.virginiaswimming.com after the conclusion of the meet.
FACILITY RULES:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Swimmer/Spectator Conduct: Each club is responsible for supervising the conduct of its swimmers/spectators. Any swimmer/spectator who violates Aquatic Center rules, posted at the pool, will be disqualified from the meet and escorted from the facility. Please note that the City of Newport News prohibits food of any kind in the pool area; permissible beverages inside the pool area are limited to those in closed containers (e.g. sports and plastic bottles with screw-on caps). Deck Access: Access to the pool deck will be strictly controlled. Swimmers, coaches, officials and event staff are the only people permitted behind the blocks. Spectators are asked to remain behind the ropes setup on the sides of the pool. Please stay in the seating area as much as possible and not view the meet from the deck during warm-ups and the competition. Team Areas: Team seating will be available in the gymnasium and limited space in the pool area. No swim bags will be allowed in the pool area. Swimmers should keep their bags in the gym. Please note that the City of Newport News requires everyone leaving the pool area and entering any other part of the facility to wear shoes (sandals/flip-flops) Spectator Seating: Bleacher seating will be available for spectators. Please note that the City of Newport News prohibits coolers or chairs in the pool area. They are allowed in the gym. Parking: Please note that there is a one-way traffic pattern that circles the building. Park only in designated (marked) parking spots. Overflow parking is available at Hines Middle School
