	•	No on deck USA Swimming athlete registration will be permitted.
	•	Age on <b>January 4, 2014</b> will determine age for the entire meet.

SWIMMERS:	•	Athletes with a disability are welcomed and shall provide advance notice of desired accommodations to the Meet Director.
	•	The athlete (or the athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the session referee of any disability prior to the competition.
FORMAT:	•	All 11 & Younger swimmers will swim in the morning (Session 1 Saturday and Session 3 Sunday). This session will offer events for 7 & Under, 9 & Under, and 10-11 age groups.
	•	All 12 & Older swimmers will swim in the afternoon Session 2 Saturday and Session 4 Sunday. These sessions offer events for 12-13, 14 & over age groups.
	•	A Distance session will follow Session 4 for 12&O swimmers (Events 119-120)
	•	All events will be timed finals.
WARM-UP:	•	Morning sessions: Warm-ups at 8:00 am; competition starts at 9:10 am.
	•	Afternoon sessions:
		• Saturday: Warm-ups no earlier than 12:30 pm; competition starts no earlier than 1:40 pm
		<ul> <li>Sunday: Warm-ups no earlier than 12:00 pm; competition starts no earlier than 1:10 pm</li> </ul>
	•	Distance Session: The pool will be opened for 10 minutes of open warm-up immediately following the finish of the last event of the previous session. The distance session competition will start 5 minutes thereafter.
	•	Lane assignment and warm-up times for individual clubs will be posted on the VAST website no later than Wednesday, January <b>1</b> , <b>2014</b> and will also be emailed to the contact person of the participating clubs.

	•	Entries must be submitted in short course yard times using Hy-Tek Team Manager and Commlink-2 software, or on a VSI master entry sheet.			
	•	Teams submit entries via e-mail.			
	•	A Team Manager printout of entries must be included or the meet checklist/summary sheet with the name, phone number, and email address of the person to contact in case of questions must accompany the entries, regardless of how they are submitted.			
	•	Coach Times (CT) and "No Time" (NT) entries will be accepted for events in which a swimmer does not have a time of record. CT must be slower than an "A" time. All entry times other than CT must have been achieved in USA Swimming sanctioned, approved, or observed competition.			
	•	Swimmers may enter a maximum of 5 individual events and 2 relay events per day.			
	•	Relay teams must be designated A, B, C, etc., if more than one per club is entered per event.			
	•	Entries will be processed in the order received and <u>accepted to</u> the greatest extent possible without exceeding the 4-hour/session timeline limit.			
	•	The Meet Director reserves the right to limit entries in any events, if necessary, to prevent too lengthy a session. This may include combining heats and events, which actions may require reseeding.

	<ul> <li>Positive check in for Events 33-34 (500 Free) and Events 119-120 (1000 Free).</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Positive check in for Events 33-34 will close at 9:45AM. We reserve the right to limit the entries of event 33-34 due to the four-hour rule.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Positive check in for Events 119-120 will close 45 minutes after the conclusion of Sunday afternoon warm-ups</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>SWIMMERS FAILING TO POSITIVELY CHECK-IN WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO SWIM THE EVENT.</li> </ul>
	• Distance session will follow Sunday afternoon session for swimming of all ages (Events #119-120)
	• Event #119-120 (1000 Free) will be swum fastest to slowest alternating girls heats with boys heats. A qualifying time for the 1000 free will be at least a BB time for the 200 Free.
PENALTIES:	Penalties for entries using fraudulent and/or non-verifiable entry times:
	<ul> <li>Swimmer shall be marked as exhibition for the event entered illegally and the event shall be re-scored and awarded.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Club may be fined \$100 for each offense, and a record of such offenses shall be kept and published as part of the official meet results.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Clubs entering swimmers not legally registered with USA Swimming before the first day of the meet may be fined \$100 per swimmer in each event so entered.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>If the swimmer is representing a club in competition, the fine will be levied on the Club. If the swimmer is unattached, the fine will be levied on the swimmer.</li> </ul>
RULES:	The current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations will apply.
	<ul> <li>Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USAS member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>The overhead start procedure may be used at the discretion of the Referee.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Use of audio or visual recording devices, including cell phones, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. In addition, photography behind the blocks is <u>not permitted</u>.</li> </ul>
	• Except where venue facilities require otherwise, changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is not appropriate and is strongly discouraged.
	<ul> <li>In accordance with VSI Policy, only those coaches who have current, valid USA Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet.</li> </ul>
	Coaches with valid USA Swimming credentials who are unable to provide them upon request will be issued temporary credentials by the meet director
	Coaches with expired or non-current credentials will be required to leave the deck area.

	<ul> <li>Team Officials Chairpersons should submit the names and session availability of certified officials, a well as the names and session availability of trainees to Jeff Sheffer no later than Wednesday, January 1, 2014.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Officials will meet on the pool deck one hour before the start of any session.</li> </ul>
SAFETY:	Virginia Swimming Meet Safety Procedures will be in effect.

TIMERS:	•	Clubs will be required to provide timers in proportion to the number of swimmers they have entered in each session.
	•	The number of timers required per club and their lane assignments will be posted on the VAST website no later than Wednesday, January 1, 2014 and will also be emailed to the contact person of each of the individual clubs.
	•	Swimmers competing in the 500 Free and 1000 Free are responsible for providing their own lap counters and timers. These are events 33,34,119,&120
GENERAL:	•	Heat Sheets will be sold for \$5.
	•	Swimmers are not permitted in any room of the building not directly associated with this swim meet.
	•	Aramark of JMU will provide concessions.
	•	Pro-shop will be available.
	•	Hospitality: VAST will provide Hospitality for coaches and officials. Breakfast and lunch will be served. Drinks and snacks will be provided during the day.
	•	All results will be posted in the hallway near the spectator stand.
FACILITY RULES:	•	The gym and a viewing area above the pool will be available both days. Some areas may be marked off limits. Please obey signage.
	•	Access to the pool will be limited to swimmers, coaches, officials, staff and timers.
	•	No smoking is permitted in the building.
	•	No food or drink on the pool deck.
	•	Please be courteous in sharing the locker rooms and bathrooms by keeping them neat.
