	No on deck Virginia Swimming athlete registration will be permitted.
	8 and younger swimmers may compete in any 8 and under event regardless of their time. 8 and younger swimmers may compete in any 10 and under event in which they have a time that is slower than the age group championship qualifying time.
	14 and younger swimmers may compete in any event in which they have a time that is slower than the age group championship qualifying time.
	• 15 and older swimmers may compete in any event in which they have a time that is slower than the senior championship qualifying time.
	Swimmers may not swim a relay in a corresponding event in which they possess an Age Group Championship (14 and younger) or Senior Championship (15 and older) qualifying time.
	Age on July 12, 2013 will determine age for the entire meet.
	• 10 & 12 year old swimmers aging up from July 12 to July 25, 2013, and 14 year old swimmers aging up from July 12 to July 18, 2013, with times too fast to qualify for this championship will be allowed to compete under the following conditions:
	 Any 10 or 12 year old swimmer who does not qualify in their new age group at Age Group Champs may enter the event.
	 Any 14 year swimmer who does not qualify for Senior Champs may enter the event
	 10, 12, & 14 year old swimmers aging up between championships will be seeded correctly by time, however will swim exhibition only, and will not be eligible to receive an award.
DISABILITY SWIMMERS:	Athletes with a disability are welcomed and shall provide advance notice of desired accommodations to the Meet Director.
	The athlete (or the athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the session referee of any disability prior to the competition.
FORMAT:	All Events will be timed finals.

12 and younger swimmers will swim in the morning sessions 13 and older swimmers will swim in the afternoon sessions. WARM-UP: Morning sessions: Friday: Warm-ups at 7:00 AM; Competition starts at 8:40 AM Saturday and Sunday: Warm-ups at 6:30 AM; competition starts at 8:10 AM. Afternoon sessions: Warm-ups not before 12:00 PM; competition starts not before 1:00 PM. Distance session (800 Free): The pool will be opened for 15 min. of open warm-ups immediately following the finish of the afternoon session with competition starting 5 min. thereafter. The approximate start time for the distance sessions will be posted on the RAYS website www.swimrays.org, no later than Tuesday, July 9, 2013, and will also be emailed to the contact person of the participating clubs. The distance session will start no earlier than the estimated times. Lane assignment and warm-up times for individual clubs will be posted on the RAYS website www.swimrays.org, no later than Tuesday, July 9, 2013 and will also be emailed to the contact person of the participating clubs. If the morning session runs late, afternoon warm-ups will begin immediately after the morning session ends. **ENTRIES:** DEADLINE FOR THE RECEIPT OF ENTRIES IS TUESDAY, JULY 2, 2013. Conforming and Non Conforming times will be used for entry – Long Course Meters then Short Course Meters then Short Course Yards using Hy-Tek Team Manager and Commlink-2 software, or on a VSI master entry sheet. Teams submit entries via e-mail. A Team Manager printout of entries must be included or the VSI meet summary sheet (available at VSI website, www.virginiaswimming.org with the name of the person to contact in case of questions must accompany the entries, regardless of how they are submitted. Swimmer may enter a maximum of 9 individual events, no more than 3 per day, and 1 relay per day. "No Time" (NT) entries will be accepted. Relay teams must be designated A, B, or C, if more than one per club is entered per event. Teams may submit three (3) relays per event. Relay entry times must be slower than the combined VSI LC Age Group Championship qualifying time for 14 & younger swimmers and must be slower than the combined VSI LC Senior Championship qualifying time for 15 & older swimmers for the corresponding relay. See the "not faster than" relay times chart on page 5. The Meet Director reserves the right to combine heats and events, which actions may require reseeding. Proof of Entry time, if requested, must be provided to the Age Group Chair within two (2) weeks of the request. Times not satisfactorily proved in that length of time will be considered nonverifiable and a fine will be assessed. Email entries to: Delwyn Jones - djones@gmail.com Late entries will be accepted. All late entries must submit proof of time. If received prior to the printing of the heat sheet, the swimmer will be seeded into the event; if after, he/she will go in the slowest heat in an empty lane. If needed, a heat will be added. FEES: Individual events: \$ 7.00 Relay events: \$ 12.00 Swimmer surcharge: \$ 2.50 per person (entered in the meet in any capacity) Late Fees: In addition to the regular entry fee, a fee of \$10 per event prior to the first day of the meet and \$25 per event on or after the first day of the meet will be charged for any entry received after the entry deadline. AWARDS:	 Individual events in the A/BB category will be awarded medals for first through fourth, and ribbons for fifth through eighth place.
	Individual events in the B/C category will be awarded ribbons for first through eighth place.
	The 800 freestyle will be awarded as 13-14 and 15 & over.
	Relay events will be awarded ribbons for first through fourth place.
SEEDING:	All events, except the 400 and 800 freestyles, and the 400 IM's and the relays will be preseded.
	The above events will require a positive check-in to swim.
	Positive check-in will close at 9:00 AM Friday, for event #23-28.
	Positive check-in will close at 1:30 PM Friday, for event #45-52.
	Positive check-in will close at 9:00 AM Saturday, for event #71-78.
	Positive check-in will close at 1:30 PM Saturday, for event #83-86 event #95-98.
	Positive check-in will close at 1:30 PM Sunday, for event #127-128.
	SWIMMERS FAILING TO POSITIVELY CHECK-IN WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO SWIM THE EVENT.
	 Event #127-128 (800 Freestyle) will be swum fastest to slowest and alternating heats of girls and boys.
PENALTIES:	Penalties for entries using fraudulent and/or non-verifiable entry times:
	 Swimmer shall be marked as exhibition for the event entered illegally and the event shall be re-scored and awarded.
	 Club may be fined \$100 for each offense, and a record of such offenses shall be kept and published as part of the official meet results.
	• Clubs entering swimmers not legally registered with USA Swimming by the first day of the meet may be fined \$100 per swimmer in each event so entered.
	• If the swimmer is representing a club in competition, the fine will be levied on the Club. If the swimmer is unattached, the fine will be levied on the swimmer.
	 A \$50 fine will be levied against any swimmer who positively checks-in and declares their intent to swim for a distance event and does not show up to compete.
RULES:	The current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations will apply.
	All swimmers participating in the meet must be dive certified.
	 Swimmers unaccompanied by a USA-S coach must be certified by a USA-S coach as proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water.
	o Ensuring compliance is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian
	The overhead start procedure will be used for the all sessions.
	 Use of audio or visual recording devices, including cell phones, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. In addition, photography behind the blocks is <u>not permitted</u>.
	• Except where venue facilities require otherwise, changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is not appropriate and is strongly discouraged.
	 In accordance with VSI Policy, only those coaches who have current, valid USA Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet
	 Coaches who have valid USA Swimming credentials but who are unable to provide them upon request will be issued temporary credentials by the meet director

	There will be an officials' meeting approximately 1 hour prior to the start of each session.		
SAFETY:	SI Safety and Warm-up procedures will be in effect.		
TIMERS:	Clubs will be required to provide timers in proportion to the number of swimmers they have entered in each session.		
	The number of timers required per club and their lane assignments will be posted on the RAYS website – www.swimrays.org , no later than Tuesday, July 9, 2013, and will also be emailed to the contact person of each of the individual clubs.		
	Swimmers are expected to provide their own timers and lap counters for event #127-128 (800 Freestyle)		
GENERAL:	Swimmer / Spectator Conduct: Each club is responsible for supervising the conduct of its swimmers / spectators.		
	• Scoreboard: the large wall mounted scoreboard is not functioning. It is currently broken and will not be able to be replaced in time for this meet. This is beyond the control of the host team. We will have a one line scoreboard. Live meet results will be available on Meet Mobile. Results will be posted in several places in the aquatic center.		
	Deck Access: Limited to athletes, coaches with their credentials, officials, timers and individuals helping with the working of the meet.		
	Team Areas: Seating is available on deck and in the gym for swimmers		
	• Spectator Seating : May not be reserved and saving of seats is not allowed. No coolers larger than a 6 pack lunch box will be allowed in the stands. Swim bags can not be brought into the spectator bleachers.		
	Team Banners: Please coordinate hanging of team banners with lifeguard on duty		
	Programs: Will be available for purchase by session or at a discount for the entire meet.		
	Snack Bar: Concessions will be available for purchase.		
	Swim Supplies: All American Swim Supply will be available in a racquetball court		
	First Aid: Located in glass guard room at the turn end of the pool		
	Lost and Found: Located in guard room or front desk.		
	• Hospitality : Will not open until warm ups begin each day. Will stop serving breakfast ½ hour after competition starts, snacks available, lunch from 12:30-2:00, snacks and drinks available until ½ hour before conclusion of the afternoon session.		
FACILITY	Each session is limited to 500 swimmers by the facility		
RULES:	No cars are to be left in the fire lanes.		
	The facility no longer allows parking in the lot adjacent to the facility. Drop off points will be provided for the discharging of swimmers and directions will be given to the overflow parking lots.
